- Title
 - Name and picture (or drawing) of your Hidden Hero
 - A brief biography including where they were born, lived, their education, why you selected this person, other interesting facts
 - A picture of their contribution or invention
 - Write a brief description of how this contribution or invention helped society
 - Include your class name

- You receive extra credit for contributing to the class poster
 - Write a paragraph describing your individual contribution
 - Must have a source page documenting where you found information
 - Bonus extra credit if and only if your poster wins the entire school competition
